


MEMBERS*

Medicaid covers nearly 1 out of every 5 South Carolinians and approximately 3 out of every 5 children in the state.

83% of South Carolinians who have Medicaid coverage were covered under full Medicaid benefits in June 2018, compared to 17% who had limited benefits.


The largest full-benefit eligibility group in June 2018 was Children, ages 0-18 (62%), followed by Other Adults, ages 19-64 (31%), and Older Adults, ages 65+ (7%).

As of June 2018, 59% of full-benefit Medicaid recipients were female and 41% were male.



FULL-BENEFIT MEMBERS BY PLAN TYPE

Fee-for-service participants represented 27% of all full-benefit enrollees, while 73% were associated with a managed care plan.
