Medicaid Enrollment in South Carolina

JUNE 2020 MONTHLY SNAPSHOT

MEMBERS*

Medicaid covers nearly 1 out of every 5 South Carolinians and approximately 3 out of every 5 children in the state.

79% of South Carolinians who have Medicaid coverage had full Medicaid benefits in June 2020, compared to 21% who had limited benefits.

The largest full-benefit eligibility group in June 2020 was Children, ages 0-18 (67%), followed by Adults, ages 19-64 (31%), and Older Adults, ages 65+ (2%).

As of June 2020, 57% of full-benefit Medicaid recipients were female and 43% were male.

FULL-BENEFIT MEMBERS BY PLAN TYPE

Fee-for-service participants represented 20% of all full-benefit enrollees, while 80% were associated with a managed care plan.
