CREATE A NEW PATIENT REQUEST

- ◆ Click <MENU>, then <PATIENT REQUEST>
- ◆ Input required fields: FIRST NAME, LAST NAME, DOB (mm/dd/yyyy)

WANT TO SEARCH IN OTHER STATES?

Check the box(es) next to the desired state(s) under 'PMP InterConnect Search'

PATIENT NOT FOUND OR WANT TO EXPAND SEARCH?

Inspect required fields for errors. If there is no error:

- ◆ Check partial spelling box under first and/or last name and enter first 3 letters of the name along with DOB (mm/dd/yyyy)
- ◆ If patient has more than one first or last name, run multiple patient requests (e.g., one for Smith-Doe and one for Doe-Smith)

MULTIPLE PATIENTS FOUND?

If multiple patients are found that match the search criteria:

- ◆ When you see a scrollbar, be sure to view all patient results
- ◆ Check the box(es) next to the patient name(s) that correspond to your patient, then click <RUN REPORT> to complete your patient request
 - Be sure to **ONLY SELECT** the records of patient you intend to search
- ◆ To modify search criteria before completing the patient request, click <REFINE SEARCH CRITERIA>

SEARCH FOR MULTIPLE PATIENTS AT ONCE

- ◆ Click <MENU>, then <BULK PATIENT SEARCH>
- ◆ Input required fields: FIRST NAME, LAST NAME, DOB (mm/dd/yyyy) and click <ADD>, then repeat
- ◆ Input a Group Name (e.g., today's date), then click <SEARCH>
- ◆ Scroll to the top and click <BULK PATIENT HISTORY>
- ◆ Select Group Name
- ◆ Click desired patient row, then click <VIEW> to view the report; repeat for each patient you wish to view

RUN AN UPDATED PATIENT REQUEST (i.e., update a previous patient request for today's date)

- ◆ Click <MENU>, then <REQUESTS HISTORY>
- ◆ Click <ADVANCED OPTIONS>, then enter desired field (e.g., last name)
- ◆ Click <SEARCH>, then select patient of interest by clicking anywhere on row and click <REFRESH>
- ◆ Check 'I agree to the terms of the acknowledgment', then click <SEARCH>

Note: Your request history is maintained for up to 6 years

VIEW THE HISTORY OF PRESCRIPTIONS YOU HAVE WRITTEN

- ◆ Click <MENU>, then <MyRx>
- ◆ Enter chosen date (mm/dd/yyyy) range for the search
- ◆ Check box(es) next to DEA numbers you wish to search
- ◆ Click <SEARCH>

Note: For best results, do not enter a drug name or choose a date longer than one month

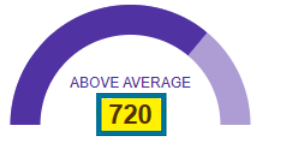

REVIEWING SCRIPTS NARX REPORTS [CONT'D]

Narx Scores are calculated based on amount of medication dispensed, number of prescribers, number of pharmacies, and overlapping prescriptions

Overdose Risk Score (ORS) is intended to be a predictive score of risk for unintentional overdose death based on key contributing factors to ORS Model

UNINTENTIONAL OVERDOSE RISK SCORE MODEL

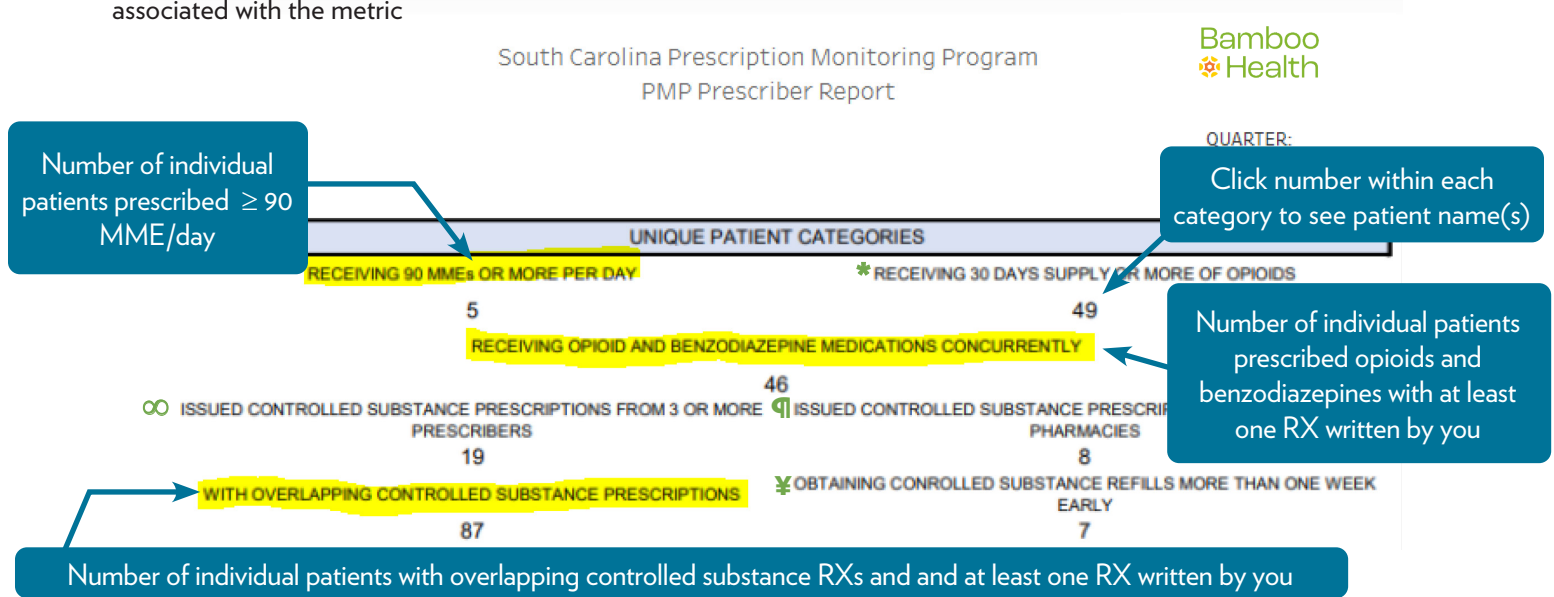

REVIEWING PRESCRIBER REPORT

PRESCRIBER REPORTS DISPLAY PATIENT RECORDS FOR EACH METRIC WHEN YOU LOG INTO YOUR SCRIPTS ACCOUNT

- Click <MENU> then <PRESCRIBER REPORT> to open your report
- Click the number under the metric within the Unique Patient Categories to see individual patient records associated with the metric



- * Number of unique patients that filled an opioid you prescribed with a 30 day or more supply
- ∞ Number of unique patients that filled a controlled substance you prescribed who also filled controlled substances from at least 2 other prescribers
- ¶ Number of unique patients that filled a controlled substance you prescribed who filled controlled substance prescriptions at 3 or more pharmacies
- ¥ Number of unique patients that you prescribed a controlled substance who refilled the prescription more than 7 days early based on the original fill date and the listed days supply

To generate a report, prescriber must be registered in the **SCRIPTS** database and have written for at least one controlled substance in the previous six months. Prescriber reports are generated through Bamboo Health and not reviewed by SC DPH.

SCRIPTS DOs AND DON'Ts

DO	DON'T
Routinely check all patients to ensure safe prescribing of controlled substances	Query yourself or anyone else that is not your patient
Have a delegate register with SCRIPTS and use their own account	Share your SCRIPTS account information or password
Discuss the report with other prescribers if they are involved in the patient's care	Share or distribute reports with other prescribers or pharmacists
Properly shred or delete reports printed or saved to computers	Scan a report into a patient's medical record
Discuss the report with your patient and refer requests for written copies to SCRIPTS at 803-896-0688	Give a printed copy of the report to your patient
